

MSJ Minis – Nursery Terms & Conditions

- The Nursery Terms & Conditions should be read in conjunction with the School's Admissions Policy and the School Parent Contract.
- All funded hours are free of charge.
- All 3 and 4 year olds can access 15 free hours of childcare starting on 1st January, 1st April and 1st September following their 3rd birthday and ending the term that they turn 5.
- Funded hours can be taken Monday to Friday from 08.00 to 15.30. Pupils are required to attend for the full day.
- The School accepts childcare vouchers and tax-free childcare payments.
- An additional 15 hours funding (equating to a maximum 30 hours) is available to eligible families.
- A family can access solely the 15 hours or 30 hours and not have to pay for additional hours.
- Pupils eligible for Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP) funding receive additional support to cover the costs of trips, uniform and the compulsory daily lunch charge.
- A minimum commitment of two days per week is recommended
- While we try to be accommodating to family needs, priority will be given to full-time pupils.
- A completed and signed registration form is required to reserve a place.
- We require parents to complete a general medical form to support your child's welfare in line with our statutory and safeguarding responsibilities to care for your child's needs.
- A refundable £100 deposit is required to secure a place and will be refunded on completion of the pupil's first term.
- Any non-funded hours plus the daily compulsory charge for hot lunches and snacks will be charged termly in advance.
- Additional charging such as for trips will be charged termly in arrears.
- Invoices are payable in advance within seven days of the start of each term.
- Lunches and snacks are charged at £3.00 per day.
- Uniform is purchased through School Blazer, the School's uniform provider. Non branded items can be bought independently of School Blazer. MSJ Mini's nursery class are only required to purchase the Pre-Prep PE uniform, however, have the option to purchase any other items of Pre-Prep Uniform.
- Consumables such as nappies and sun cream should be provided by parent/guardian.
- There is a late collection charge of £15 per 15 minutes after 18:00.
- Parents wishing to withdraw their child or reduce their sessions will be required to give a full term's
 notice in writing to the Headmistress via headspa@malvernstjames.co.uk; otherwise, a full term's
 fees in lieu of notice are payable.
