



A LEVEL RESULTS 2025

A* grades were up on 2024 with 65% of all grades at A*-B. In addition, 85% of Level 3 BTEC sport grades were Distinction* and Distinction (equivalent to A* and A at A Level).

Crucially, 98% of students obtained their place at their chosen university, gaining places at the most competitive institutions: Imperial College London, UCL, Durham, Bath and Warwick, to name but a few.

Results across the curriculum evidence MSJ's consistency and excellence: 100% Computer Science grades, 60% English Literature grades and 56% Chemistry grades were A* and A.

GCSE RESULTS 2025

Over a third of grades were at the top 9 and 8 with an increase in Grade 9 from 2024, while 50% are at grades 9-7 and 70% are at grades 9-6 (A*-B equivalent). We are very proud to once again have exceptional Value Added at 0.9 for 2025. This means that, on average, every student achieved almost one grade higher in *every single subject* than national expectations, due to excellent teaching and learning.

Once again, we have a 100% pass rate in all subjects and students averaged a Grade 7 across the cohort. The range of subjects in which students have excelled shows the breadth of ability and interests amongst the cohort and were particularly impressive last year.
